INTERESTED IN SERVING YOUR COMMUNITY?

There are a number of positions coming available to include City Council, Planning and Zoning and Board of Adjustment.



CITY COUNCIL: City of Salix is a Mayor/Council form of government who are elected by the people of the City. The Mayor is elected to a 4 year term. The Mayor is not a member of the Council and therefore may not vote as a member of the Council. The Council consists of 5 members who serve 4 year terms. The Council adopts all ordinances and resolutions and determines the general goals and policies of the City. Salix currently has openings for the Mayors seat and 4 Council seats. If you are interested in serving on the council, you can pick up nomination papers at City Hall. Candidates may file nomination papers beginning August 23rd until 5pm September 16th. Elections will be held on Tuesday, November 2nd.



PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION: The Planning and Zoning Commission (P&Z) is intended to protect, maintain, and develop an attractive, safe, and healthy environment.

Primary functions address property development and land use activities occurring in the City. The P&Z Commission reviews the zoning ordinance and City's Comprehensive plan and makes recommendations to the City Council on zoning issues, improvements, annexation, growth, transportation & economic development. The Salix P&Z Commission consists of 5 members (3 serve a 5 year term and 2 serve a 3 year term). There is one – 3 year term positions available which is appointed by the City Council.



BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT: The Board of Adjustment also hears and reviews variances and appeals from any zoning ordinances, if applicable, from the Planning and Zoning Commission. The

Board of Adjustment votes on applications of conditional or temporary use permits. The Salix Board of Adjustment consists of five members as determined by the City Council and hold staggering term limits. There are four positions open on the Board of Adjustment (a 5 year, 3 year, 2 year and 1 year term available – all appointed by the City Council).
