FIREWORKS REMINDER

The use of fireworks is permitted:

June 1st through July 8th between the hours of 9:00am and 10:00pm

However, on July 4th and the Saturdays and Sundays immediately preceding and following July 4th, the hours increase to 9am – 11pm. The state law allows cities and counties to prohibit or limit the use of fireworks. The Salix City Council currently sees no reason to prohibit or limit use as long as neighbors continue to celebrate safely and adhere to the allowed timeframes. Please be cautious of weather and courteous to your neighbors.

CHANGES TO WATER AND GARBAGE RATES

The council has approved three readings for changes to water and garbage rates. The Water Debt Relief Fee will decrease by \$1 per month and water usage will increase by 3%. Garbage rates will increase to \$13.50 for a small can and \$15.50 for a large can. In addition, landfill rates will increase .55cents per can. Changes will be effective July 1st, 2021.
