SERVICE LINE WARRANTIES OF AMERICA (SWLA)

As a Salix homeowner, you will begin to see mailings from a company called Utility Service Partners/Service Line Warranties of America (SWLA). These mailings contain information about a homeowner's opportunity, but not the obligation, to purchase a service line warranty for water and sewer line repairs. Salix Code of Ordinances state that the homeowner is responsible for any repairs for service lines that run from the MAIN to the HOUSE, including the curb stop. Breaks and leaks to these lines can cost thousands of dollars to repair. You may already have some coverage for service line repairs on your current homeowner's policy. It is advantageous for homeowners to review this coverage with their insurance agent. If you are not covered, please consider separate coverage from Service Line Warranties of America. NUISANCE ABATEMENT PROGRAM

The City of Salix is beginning to take action on nuisance issues around the town by working with a third party to assist us with nuisances that are a safety hazard, reduce property valuation and promote a negative image. Common issues are:

- Unlicensed/inoperative vehicles
- Uncontrolled weeds, grass, trees and brush
- Buildings with broken windows or doors
- Outbuildings in disrepair
- Vacant houses/buildings

An unbiased third party will be traveling around town to provide the City Council with a list of properties that they feel have are immediate concerns. The council will review the list during the June council meeting and letters will be sent following the meeting. If you have been meaning to "get around to" that particular thing to clean up, now is the time!
