It's time to clean out those attics, basements, and garages!! The City of Salix will be holding a Clean Up weekend this Spring. Look for specific dates and drop off times in the April newsletter. Disposal cost is free for city residents (if you currently pay a monthly garbage bill to the city).



Take advantage of the longer daylight and calmer weather. Now is a great time to:

- ✓ Check and replace the batteries in your smoke and carbon monoxide alarms. (Replace smoke alarms older than 10 years.)
- ✓ Be ready for a storm. Prepare or replenish a disaster supply kit for your house (water, food, flashlights, batteries, blankets).
- ✓ Inspect gutters and downspouts for damage and debris (working gutters ensure that water is diverted from your home's foundation).
- ✓ Trim trees and shrubs to prevent damage to siding, windows or roof.
- ✓ Inspect and tune up any lawn maintenance equipment (sharpen tools, change batteries, lubricate moving parts and replace old gas).
- ✓ Clean debris from foundation vents and window wells.
- ✓ Inspect caulking around doors and windows for damage or wear (replace, if necessary, to increase energy efficiency).
- ✓ Inspect wooden railings, decks, windowsills and steps for rot.
