It's time to clean out those attics, basements and garages!! The City of Salix will be holding one clean up weekend this year but will extend drop off times to 4 days vs. 2 days. Garbage items should be brought to the east side of the maintenance shop on Tipton Street (across from the post office). All items will be checked by an attendant. You will be asked your name, address and type of material that you will be dumping. The landfill increased their rates for TVs, therefore, the charge for dropping of a TV will increase to \$25.00 which can be paid at drop off or can be charged to your utility bill. Appliances can be dropped off on a separate trailer for no charge. Those appliances include: stove, washing machine, dryer, air conditioner, microwave, water heater, fridge, freezer, furnace, etc. Disposal cost for all other items is free for city residents (if you currently pay a monthly garbage bill to the city). Paint, tires, cement, broken glass or other hazardous materials will not be accepted. Batteries will be accepted but must be placed outside of dumpsters, as they are not allowed in the landfill. Please call City Hall if you would like to arrange a special drop off time or if you have any questions.
