FRIDAY, MAY 13th – SUNDAY, MAY 15th

It's time to clean out those attics, basements and garages!! The City of Salix will be holding the annual Spring Clean Up May 13th – 15th. Drop off times are as follows:

FRI, MAY 13: 5pm – 7pm

SAT, MAY 14: 11:30am – 2:30pm

SUN, MAY 15: 1pm – 3pm

Disposal cost is free for city residents (who currently pay for garbage services billed through the City of Salix). All drop-offs will be checked by an attendant.

Paint, tires, cement, broken glass, construction material or hazardous materials are not accepted.

There is a \$25 charge for each TV disposal. Cash accepted by attendant or you may ask to have it charged to your garbage bill.

Most appliances will be accepted (ie: stoves, washing machines, dryers, air conditioners, microwaves, water heaters, etc.) but are to be placed on a separate trailer for recycling.

DISCONNECTION OF WATER SERVICE

Water/Sewer/Garbage bills are mailed around the 1st of each month. They are due by the 15th. On the 16th, if payment has not been made a 10% penalty is added to the account. If payment is not received by the 20th, disconnection notices are sent. This is the final notice. The City of Salix will not make courtesy calls to repeat offenders to warn of disconnection. If the water is disconnected, an additional trip charge of \$25 to turn off and \$25 to turn off is applied to the bill.



Triple C Pest Control will begin fogging for mosquitos on Monday evenings starting May 23rd (weather permitting). While the insecticide is safe for people, animals and plants, it is not recommended to intentionally breathe the mist.
