RECYCLING – KEEP IT SIMPLE WHEN IN DOUBT, LEAVE IT OUT!

We know when it comes to recycling, there are a lot of things that are "recyclable". However, as part of the single-stream recycling program with the City of Salix, only plastic, cardboard, paper, aluminum and tin are accepted. LP Gill is having to discard many items that have been put in our dumpster because it isn't something they can collect. When you want to recycle through the city's program, please keep it simple. When in doubt, leave it out!



ALUMINUM & TIN

Acceptable items include: fruit and vegetable cans, metal lids from glass jars and bottles, pet food cans, coffee cans. All items must be rinsed.



PLASTIC

Acceptable items include: milk jugs, drink bottles, detergent bottles, and food containers. All items must be rinsed.



CARDBOARD & PAPER PRODUCTS

Acceptable items include: newspaper, magazines, office/computer paper, junk mail, brown paper sacks, wrapping paper, corrugated cardboard, toy boxes, waxed food cartons, pop and beer containers, detergent boxes. Boxes must be emptied and broken down flat.



NO GLASS, PLASTIC BAGS, PLASTIC STRAWS, STYROFOAM, YARD WASTE OR ANY OTHER MATERIAL IS ACCEPTED AS PART OF SINGLE-STREAM RECYCLING.

COVID RELIEF

Have you experienced a financial hardship due to the COVID-19 pandemic and need help with your utility bills? The Iowa Residential Utility Disruption Prevention Program provides eligible households with up to \$2,000 towards electric, natural gas and water bills if they are at risk of disconnection due to an inability to pay due to a COVID-19 related loss of income.
