## WINTER REMINDERS

Living in Iowa, we all know just how unpredictable our weather can be. Although we don't like to think about it, winter storms may be here before we know it. To help us make snow removal from streets faster and easier, here are some friendly reminders....

**OFF STREET STORAGE:** All recreational vehicles including boats, trailers, RV's, farm equipment, etc. need to be moved to permanent storage areas before November 15<sup>th</sup>.

**SNOW EMERGENCY:** Snow emergency procedures go into effect anytime there is a snowfall of two inches or more. All vehicles must be moved from the streets during a snow emergency so that City Maintenance has access to the entire street. Help make snow removal safer for city personnel by removing your vehicles when snowfall is expected.
