It's time to clean out those attics, basements and garages and get rid of those larger bulkier items that won't fit in your garbage can!! The City of Salix will be holding a clean-up weekend Friday, October 23rd through Monday, October 26th. If you currently pay a garbage bill to the City of Salix, this is a free service to you. Garbage items should be brought to the east side of the maintenance shop on Tipton Street (across from the post office). All items will be checked by an attendant. You will be asked your name, address and type of material that you will be dumping. There is a \$25 charge for TV's, which can be paid at drop off or can be charged to your utility bill. Appliances can be dropped off on a separate trailer for no charge. Those appliances include: stove, washing machine, dryer, air conditioner, microwave, water heater, fridge, freezer, furnace, etc. **Paint, tires, cement, glass, housing construction or hazardous materials will not be accepted.** Batteries will be accepted but must be placed outside of dumpsters, as they are not allowed in the landfill. SERVICE LINE WARRANTIES OF AMERICA

Utility Service Partners/Service Line Warranties of America (SWLA) will once again be sending mailings to Salix residents that contain information about a homeowner's opportunity, but not the obligation, to purchase a service line warranty for water and sewer line repairs. Salix Code of Ordinances state that the homeowner is responsible for any repairs for service lines that run from the MAIN to the HOUSE, including the curb stop. Breaks and leaks to these lines can cost thousands of dollars to repair. You may already have some coverage for service line repairs on your current homeowner's policy. It is advantageous for homeowners to review this coverage with their insurance agent. If you are not covered, please consider separate coverage from Service Line Warranties of America.
